Worcestershire County Council in exercise of their powers under Section 1(1), 2 (1) to (3), 4(2) and 124 and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (which said Act is hereinafter referred to as "the Act of 1984") and of all other powers them enabling in that behalf, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the said Act of 1984, hereby make the following Order:-

- 1. The Worcestershire County Council (City of Worcester) (Civil Enforcement Area) (Waiting Restrictions and Street Parking Places) Consolidation Order 2011 is hereby varied by the attachment thereto of the plan attached to this Order (which has the effect of imposing on the roads and sides of roads identified in the plan attached to this Order a prohibition of waiting/restriction of waiting in accordance with the provisions of the Consolidation Order).
- The Order shall come into operation on XXXX 2024 and may be cited as Worcestershire County Council (City of Worcester) (Civil Enforcement Area) (Waiting Restrictions and Street Parking Places) Consolidation Order 2011 (Variation) Order 2024 [Prohibition of Waiting/Restriction of Waiting Mon-Sat 8.30-5.30pm on Shap Drive & Edgeworth Close, Worcester].

# ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 WORCESTERSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (HONISTER DRIVE & EDGEWORTH CLOSE, WORCESTER) (NO STOPPING ON SCHOOL ENTRANCE MARKINGS) ORDER 2024

Worcestershire County Council in exercise of their powers under Sections 1, 2, 3, and 4 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (which said Act is hereinafter referred to as "the Act of 1984"), and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the said Act of 1984, hereby make the following Order:-

- Save as provided in Article 2 of this Order, no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform, cause or permit any vehicle to stop at any time on School Entrance Markings as specified in the Schedule to this Order
- 2. Nothing in Article 1 of this Order shall apply:-
  - (a) to a vehicle stopping on the school entrance markings referred to in Article 1 for so long as may be necessary to enable the vehicle to be used in connection with any building operation or demolition, the removal of any obstruction to traffic, the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of the road including and comprising of the school entrance markings, or the laying, erection, alteration or repair in or near such road of any sewer or of any main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or sewer or of any main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity or of any telecommunications apparatus as defined in the Telecommunications Act 1984;
  - (b) to a vehicle being used for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes;
  - (c) to a vehicle being used in pursuance of statutory powers or duties;
  - (d) to a vehicle stopping on the school entrance markings referred to in Article 1 for so long as is necessary to enable any gate or other barrier at the entrance to premises to which the vehicle requires access or from which it has emerged to be opened or closed if it is not practicable for the vehicle to wait otherwise than on the school entrance markings.
  - (e) to a vehicle stopping on the school entrance markings referred to in Article 1 when the person in control of the vehicle:-
    - (i) is required by law to stop;

- (ii) is obliged to do so in order to avoid an accident; or
- (iii) is prevented from proceeding by circumstances outside his control and it is not reasonably practicable for him to drive or move the vehicle to a place not on the school entrance markings referred to in Article 1.
- 3. This Order shall come into operation on xxxxx 2024 and may be cited as (Honister Drive & Edgeworth Close, Worcester) (No Stopping on School Entrance Markings) Order 2024.

### PROPOSED 'NO STOPPING ON SCHOOL ENTRANCE MARKINGS MON-FRI 8.30AM-5.30PM'

#### **Honister Drive**

**North side:** from the centre point of its junction with Shap Drive for a distance of 18 metres in an easterly direction and 22 metres in a westerly direction.

#### **Edgeworth Close**

**Both sides:** from a point 46 metres south of its junction with Chedworth Drive around the turning head in its entirety.

#### Map and plan of the area

Map of Shap Drive, Edgeworth Close & Honiston Drive, Worcester and the proposed Prohibition of Waiting, Restriction of Waiting and No Stopping zones to be implemented by the above order.

#### **Description of the map**

The map shows the proposed Prohibition of Waiting, Restriction of Waiting and No Stopping zones on Shap Drive, Edgeworth Close & Honiston Drive, **Worcester:** -

**Prohibition of Waiting:** 

**Shap Drive (Both sides):** from its junction with Windermere Drive for a distance of 10 metres in a north easterly direction.

Restriction of Waiting Mon-Sat 8.30am-5.30pm:

**Shap Drive (Southeast side):** from a point 12 metres southwest of its junction with Honister Drive for a distance of 13 metres in a south westerly direction.

**Northwest side:** from a point 10 metres northeast of its junction with Windermere Drive for a distance of 10 metres in a north easterly direction.

**Edgeworth Close (West side):** from a point 10 metres south of its junction with Chedworth Drive for a distance of 36 metres in a southerly direction.

No Stopping on school entrance markings Mon-Fri 8.30am-5.30pm as follows: Honister Drive (North side): from the centre point of its junction with Shap Drive for a distance of 18 metres in an easterly direction and 22 metres in a westerly direction. Edgeworth Close (Both sides): from a point 46 metres south of its junction with Chedworth Drive around the turning head in its entirety.
