Statement of Reasons for proposing to make an Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984

WORCESTERSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (TUDOR WAY, WORCESTER) (NO STOPPING ON SCHOOL KEEP CLEAR MARKINGS) ORDER 2024

Worcestershire County Council have made this Order for facilitating the safe passage on the road or any other road of any class of traffic and for avoiding danger to persons or other traffic using the road or any other road or for preventing the likelihood of any such danger arising.

It is considered that that Order will contribute to the securing of the expeditious, safe and convenient movement of all traffic (including pedestrians) and will have no adverse effect on other considerations contained in S122 Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

The order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984

WORCESTERSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (TUDOR WAY, WORCESTER) (NO STOPPING ON SCHOOL KEEP CLEAR MARKINGS) ORDER 2024

Worcestershire County Council in exercise of their powers under Sections 1, 2, 3, and 4 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (which said Act is hereinafter referred to as “the Act of 1984”), and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the said Act of 1984, hereby make the following Order: -

1. Save as provided in Article 2 of this Order, no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform, cause or permit any vehicle to stop at any time on School Keep Clear Markings as specified in the Schedule to this Order.
2. Nothing in Article 1 of this Order shall apply: -
 - (a) to a vehicle stopping on the school keep clear markings referred to in Article 1 for so long as may be necessary to enable the vehicle to be used in connection with any building operation or demolition, the removal of any obstruction to traffic, the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of the road including and comprising of the school keep clear markings, or the laying, erection, alteration or repair in or near such road of any sewer or of any main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or sewer or of any main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity or of any telecommunications apparatus as defined in the Telecommunications Act 1984;
 - (b) to a vehicle being used for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes;
 - (c) to a vehicle being used in pursuance of statutory powers or duties;
 - (d) to a vehicle stopping on the school keep clear markings referred to in Article 1 for so long as is necessary to enable any gate or other barrier at the entrance to premises to which the vehicle requires access or from which it has emerged to be opened or closed if it is not practicable for the vehicle to wait otherwise than on the school keep clear markings.

- (e) to a vehicle stopping on the school keep clear markings referred to in Article 1 when the person in control of the vehicle: -
 - (i) is required by law to stop;
 - (ii) is obliged to do so in order to avoid an accident; or
 - (iii) is prevented from proceeding by circumstances outside his control and it is not reasonably practicable for him to drive or move the vehicle to a place not on the school keep clear markings referred to in Article 1.

3. This Order shall come into operation on 30 May 2024 and may be cited as (Tudor Way, Worcester) (No Stopping on School Keep Clear Markings) Order 2024.

2. Nothing in Article 1 of this Order shall apply: -
 - (a) to a vehicle stopping on the school keep clear markings referred to in Article 1 for so long as may be necessary to enable the vehicle to be used in connection with any building operation or demolition, the removal of any obstruction to traffic, the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of the road including and comprising of the school keep clear markings, or the laying, erection, alteration or repair in or near such road of any sewer or of any main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or sewer or of any main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity or of any telecommunications apparatus as defined in the Telecommunications Act 1984;
 - (b) to a vehicle being used for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes;
 - (c) to a vehicle being used in pursuance of statutory powers or duties;
 - (d) to a vehicle stopping on the school keep clear markings referred to in Article 1 for so long as is necessary to enable any gate or other barrier at the entrance to premises to which the vehicle requires access or from which it has emerged to be opened or closed if it is not practicable for the vehicle to wait otherwise than on the school keep clear markings.

(e) to a vehicle stopping on the school keep clear markings referred to in Article 1 when the person in control of the vehicle:

- (i) is required by law to stop;
- (ii) is obliged to do so in order to avoid an accident; or
- (iii) is prevented from proceeding by circumstances outside his control and it is not reasonably practicable for him to drive or move the vehicle to a place not on the school keep clear markings referred to in Article 1.

3. This Order shall come into operation on 30 May 2024 and may be cited as (Tudor Way, Worcester) (No Stopping on School Keep Clear Markings) Order 2024.

Tudor Way (East side): from a point 13 metres north of its junction with Stainburn Close to a point 37 metres south of its junction with Drake Avenue.
(West side): from a point 35 metres north of the centre point of its junction with Stainburn Close to a point 46 metres south of the centre point of its junction with Drake Avenue.
