## **Statement of Reasons for proposing to make an Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**

### **WORCESTERSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL BOROUGH OF REDDITCH) (CIVIL ENFORCEMENT AREA) (WAITING RESTRICTIONS AND STREET PARKING PLACES) CONSOLIDATION ORDER 2009 (VARIATION) ORDER 2024 [NO WAITING ON REDDITCH POLICE AND FIRE STATION EGRESS, REDDITCH] AND WORCESTERSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (REDDITCH POLICE AND FIRE STATION EGRESS, REDDITCH) (ONE-WAY TRAFFIC ORDER) 2024**

Worcestershire County Council propose to make an Order for avoiding danger to persons or other traffic using the road or any other road and preventing the likelihood of any such danger arising.

It is considered that the Order will contribute to the securing of the expeditious, safe and convenient movement of all traffic (including pedestrians) and will have no adverse effect on other considerations contained in s.122 Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

Worcestershire County Council in exercise of their powers under Section 1(1), 2 (1) to (3), 4(2) and 124 and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (which said Act is hereinafter referred to as "the Act of 1984") and of all other powers them enabling in that behalf, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the said Act of 1984, hereby make the following Order:-

1. The Worcestershire County Council (Borough of Redditch) (Civil Enforcement Area) (Waiting Restrictions and Street Parking Places) Consolidation Order 2009 is hereby varied by the attachment thereto of the plan attached to this Order (which has the effect of imposing on the roads and sides of roads identified in the plan attached to this Order a prohibition of waiting in accordance with the provisions of the Consolidation Order).
2. The Order shall come into operation on XXXX 2024 and may be cited as Worcestershire County Council (Borough of Redditch) (Civil Enforcement Area) (Waiting Restrictions and Street Parking Places) Consolidation Order 2009 (Variation) Order 2024 [No Waiting on Redditch Police and Fire Station Egress, Redditch].

# The order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984

## **WORCESTERSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (REDDITCH POLICE AND FIRE STATION EGRESS, REDDITCH) (ONE-WAY TRAFFIC) ORDER 2024**

Worcestershire County Council in exercise of their powers under Section 1 (1), 2 (1) to (3) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and of all other powers them enabling in that behalf, after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the said Act of 1984, hereby make the following Order:-

1. No person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police officer in uniform, or a traffic warden, cause or permit any vehicle to proceed along Redditch Police and Fire Station Egress for its entire length. Vehicles may only proceed in a west to east direction.
2. Nothing in Article 1 of this Order shall apply to any mechanical road cleansing vehicle;
3. This Order shall come into operation on XXXX 2024 and may be cited as Worcestershire County Council (Redditch Police and Fire Station Egress, Redditch) (One-Way Traffic) Order 2024.
