1. No person shall drive or cause or permit be driven any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 30 miles per hour along those roads as specified in the Schedule to this Order.
2. No speed limit imposed by this Order applies to vehicles falling within regulation 3(4) of the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011 when used in accordance with regulation 3(5) of those regulations.
3. This Order may be cited as Worcestershire County Council (Western Road, Hagley) (30 mph Speed Limit) Order 2024 and shall come into operation on 4 July 2024.
