Order Preliminaries

This Order is made by Worcestershire County Council ("the authority") under Section 119 of the Highways Act 1980 ("the 1980 Act") because it appears to the authority that in the interests of the owners of the land crossed by the footpath described in paragraph 1 of this order it is expedient that the line of the path should be diverted.

This Order is also made under section 53A(2) of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981 ("the 1981 Act") because it appears to the authority that the County of Worcestershire definitive map and statement require modification in consequence of the occurrence of an event specified in section 53(3)(a)(i) of the 1981 Act, namely, the diversion (as authorised by this order) of a highway shown or required to be shown in the map and statement.

Malvern Hills District Council have been consulted about the making of the Order as required by Section 120(2) of the 1980 Act.

Articles - By this Order

- 1. The public right of way over the land situated at Earls Croome and shown by a continuous bold line on the map contained in this Order and described in Part 1 of the Schedule to this Order shall be stopped up on the date of confirmation of this order, and thereupon the County of Worcestershire definitive map and statement shall be modified accordingly.
- 2. Notwithstanding this Order any statutory undertaker as shall for the time being have statutory powers in that respect shall have the right to open up the land referred to in paragraph 1 to install, maintain or alter their apparatus.
- 3. There shall on the date of confirmation of this order be a public footpath over the land situated in Earl's Croome described in Part 2 of the Schedule and shown by a bold broken line on the map attached to this Order, and thereupon the County of Worcestershire definitive map and statement shall be modified accordingly.
- 4. The County of Worcestershire definitive statement shall be modified as described in Part 4 of the schedule of this Order.

5. The rights conferred on the public under this Order shall be subject to the limitations and conditions set out in Part 3 of the Schedule.

FOOTPATHS EA-500

FOOTPATH EA-500 (PART) (FORMERLY FOOTPATH No. 1) IN THE PARISH OF EARLS CROOME

The length and entire width of footpath EA-500 (part) in the parish of Earls Croome to be diverted commences at Ordnance Survey Grid Reference (OSGR) SO 8602 4302 (Point A on the Order map); the footpath proceeds generally south-south-west for 220 metres to OSGR SO 8597 4281 (Point B on the Order map); turns west for 28 metres to OSGR SO 8594 4281 (Point C on the Order map); turns south-west for 207 metres to terminate at OSGR SO 8579 4268 (Point D on the Order map).

The total distance of footpath to be diverted is 455 metres.

Part 2

Description of Site of New Footpaths

FOOTPATH EA-500 (PART) (FORMERLY FOOTPATH No. 1) IN THE PARISH OF EARLS CROOME

The length of footpath EV-586 (part) in the parish of Earls Croome commences at OSGR SO 8602 4302 (Point A on the Order map) with a width of 2 metres; the footpath proceeds generally west-south-west for 90 metres to OSGR SO 8594 4299 (Point E on the Order map); turns south-south-west for 190 metres to a pedestrian gate at OSGR SO 8588 4281 (Point F on the Order map); continues south-south-west for 6 metres to a pedestrian gate at OSGR SO 8588 4280 (Point G on the Order map); turns south-west for 160 metres to OSGR SO 8579 4268 (Point D on the Order map) to join the existing footpath.

The total distance of the diverted footpath is 446 metres.

LOCATION

Commences western side A.38 at Severn Stoke – Earls Croome Parish Boundaries proceeding in south westerly direction passing through Hollybeds Farm at OSGR SO 8602 4302 with a width of 2 metres; the footpath proceeds generally west-south-west for 90 metres to OSGR SO 8594 4299; turns south-south-west for 190 metres to a pedestrian gate at OSGR SO 8588 4281; continues south-south-west for 6 metres to a pedestrian gate at OSGR SO 8588 4280; turns south-west for 160 metres to OSGR SO 8579 4268 to terminate junction western end Donkey Lane and Footpath No. 14 at Browns Hill Cottage.

Diverted under HA 1980, section 119, 2022

LENGTH Miles .33 mile = 950 yards 820 metres (0.82 Km)

DESCRIPTION

General

Commences as above with field gate (needs rehanging – barbed wire on top), and follows north eastern boundary hedge of pasture field (95 – no track), to north western corner and bearing in southerly direction western boundary hedge ending at south western corner with climbable fence (note – fenced-in enclosure (part of 95) removed). Footpath passes through farmyard north of farm ending with Field Gate and crossing south eastern corner of pasture field (98) ending with gap immediately west of farmhouse and continuing across orchard (100) OSGR SO 8602 4302, grass field to OSGR SO 8594 4299; grass field to pedestrian gate at OSGR SO 8588 4281; farm track to pedestrian gate at OSGR SO 8588 4280; grass field to OSGR SO 8579 4268; to end at south western corner with field gate. (Note – Footpath No. 11 commences at this point).

Footpath No. 1 enters pasture plot 110a follows eastern boundary hedge as cart track continuing through orchard plot 110 (note – no dividing fence) ending at southern corner with field gate and continuing through fenced in plot east of Browns Hill Cottage – tenant

Mr. Jackson – ending with field gate at junction western end Donkey Lane at Bridle Road
and Footpath No. 14.

The applicant has agreed to defray any compensation which becomes payable in consequence of the coming into force of this Order and any expenses which are incurred in bringing the new site of the footpath into a fit condition for use by the public ('the works to the new site').

Malvern Hills District Council have been consulted about the making of the Order as required by Section 120(2) of the 1980 Act.

BY THIS ORDER:

- The public right of way over the land situated at Earls Croome and shown by a bold continuous line on the map contained in this Order and described in Part 1 of the Schedule to this Order shall be stopped up on the date of confirmation of this order, and thereupon the County of Worcestershire definitive map and statement shall be modified accordingly.
- Notwithstanding this Order any statutory undertaker as shall for the time being have statutory powers in that respect shall have the right to open up the land referred to in paragraph 1 to install, maintain or alter their apparatus.
- There shall on the date of confirmation of this order be a public footpath over the land situated in Earls Croome described in Part 2 of the Schedule and shown by a bold broken line on the map attached to this Order, and thereupon the County of Worcestershire definitive map and statement shall be modified accordingly

- The County of Worcestershire definitive statement shall be modified as described in Part 4 of the schedule of this Order.
- The rights conferred on the public under this Order shall be subject to the limitations and conditions set out in Part 3 of the Schedule.
