Statement of Reasons for proposing to make an Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984

WORCESTERSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (WYRE FOREST DISTRICT – KIDDERMINSTER AREA) (PERMITTED PARKING AREA AND SPECIAL PARKING AREA) (WAITING RESTRICTIONS AND STREET PARKING PLACES) CONSOLIDATION ORDER 2007 (VARIATION) ORDER 2024 PROHIBITION OF WAITING ON C2019 AND DRAKELOW LANE, WOLVERLEY AND WORCESTERSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (C2019 WOLVERLEY) (NO STOPPING ON SCHOOL ACCESS MARKINGS) ORDER 2024

Worcestershire County Council have made this Order for facilitating the safe passage on the roads or any other roads of any class of traffic and for avoiding danger to persons or other traffic using the roads or any other roads or for preventing the likelihood of any such danger arising.

It is considered that the Order will contribute to the securing of the expeditious, safe and convenient movement of all traffic (including pedestrians) and will have no adverse effect on other considerations contained in s.122 Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 WORCESTERSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (C2019, WOLVERLEY) (NO STOPPING ON SCHOOL ACCESS MARKINGS) ORDER 2024

Worcestershire County Council in exercise of their powers under Sections 1, 2, 3, and 4 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (which said Act is hereinafter referred to as “the Act of 1984”), and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the said Act of 1984, hereby make the following Order:-

1. Save as provided in Article 2 of this Order, no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform, cause or permit any vehicle to stop at any time on School access Markings as specified in the Schedule to this Order
2. Nothing in Article 1 of this Order shall apply:-
 - (a) to a vehicle stopping on the school keep clear markings referred to in Article 1 for so long as may be necessary to enable the vehicle to be used in connection with any building operation or demolition, the removal of any obstruction to traffic, the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of the road including and comprising of the school keep clear markings, or the laying, erection, alteration or repair in or near such road of any sewer or of any main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or sewer or of any main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity or of any telecommunications apparatus as defined in the Telecommunications Act 1984;
 - (b) to a vehicle being used for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes;
 - (c) to a vehicle being used in pursuance of statutory powers or duties;
 - (d) to a vehicle stopping on the school keep clear markings referred to in Article 1 for so long as is necessary to enable any gate or other barrier at the entrance to premises to which the vehicle requires access or from which it has emerged to be opened or closed if it is not practicable for the vehicle to wait otherwise than on the school keep clear markings.

- (e)
 - (f) to a vehicle stopping on the school keep clear markings referred to in Article 1 when the person in control of the vehicle:-
 - (i) is required by law to stop;
 - (ii) is obliged to do so in order to avoid an accident; or
 - (iii) is prevented from proceeding by circumstances outside his control and it is not reasonably practicable for him to drive or move the vehicle to a place not on the school keep clear markings referred to in Article 1.
3. This Order shall come into operation on 29 August 2024 and may be cited as (C2019, Wolverley) (No Stopping on School Access Markings) Order 2024.

(NO STOPPING ON SCHOOL ACCESS MARKINGS) ORDER 2024

Worcestershire County Council in exercise of their powers under Sections 1, 2, 3, and 4 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (which said Act is hereinafter referred to as "the Act of 1984"), and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the said Act of 1984, hereby make the following Order:-

1. Save as provided in Article 2 of this Order, no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform, cause or permit any vehicle to stop at any time on School access Markings as specified in the Schedule to this Order
2. Nothing in Article 1 of this Order shall apply:-
 - (a) to a vehicle stopping on the school keep clear markings referred to in Article 1 for so long as may be necessary to enable the vehicle to be used in connection with any building operation or demolition, the removal of any obstruction to traffic, the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of the road including and comprising of the school keep clear markings, or the laying, erection, alteration or repair in or near such road of any sewer or of any main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or sewer or of any main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity or of any telecommunications apparatus as defined in the Telecommunications Act 1984;
 - (b) to a vehicle being used for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes;
 - (c) to a vehicle being used in pursuance of statutory powers or duties;
 - (d) to a vehicle stopping on the school keep clear markings referred to in Article 1 for so long as is necessary to enable any gate or other barrier at the entrance to premises to which the vehicle requires access or from which it has emerged to be opened or closed if it is not practicable for the vehicle to wait otherwise than on the school keep clear markings.

(e) to a vehicle stopping on the school keep clear markings referred to in Article 1 when the person in control of the vehicle:-

- (i) is required by law to stop;
- (ii) is obliged to do so in order to avoid an accident; or
- (iii) is prevented from proceeding by circumstances outside his control and it is not reasonably practicable for him to drive or move the vehicle to a place not on the school keep clear markings referred to in Article 1.

3. This Order shall come into operation on 29 August 2024 and may be cited as (C2019, Wolverley) (No Stopping on School Access Markings) Order 2024.

Map of C2019 and Drakelow Lane, Wolverley and the prohibition of waiting and no stopping zones implemented by the above order.

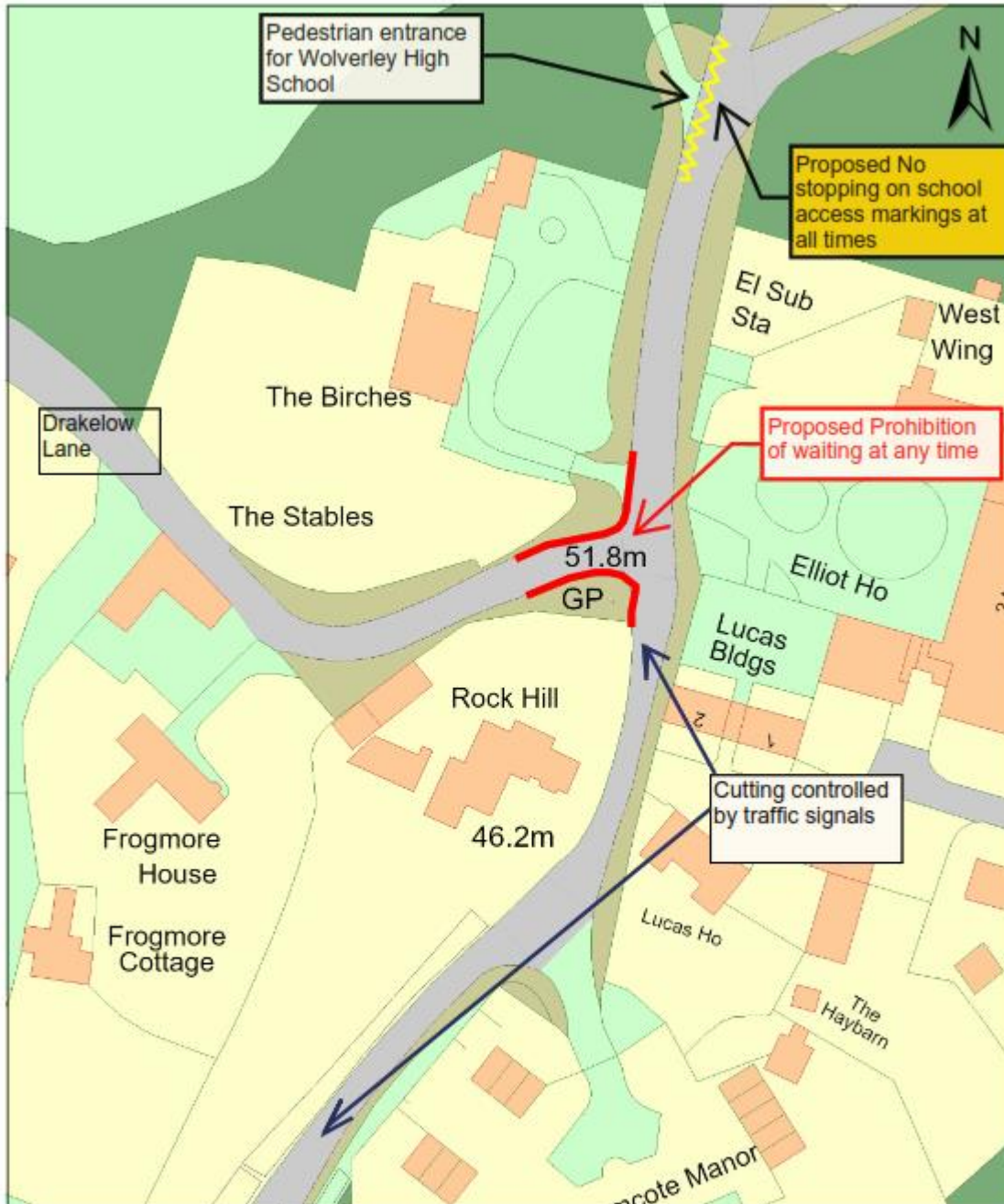
Description of the map

The map shows the prohibition of waiting and no stopping zones on the C2019 and Drakelow Lane, **Wolverley**:

C2019 (west side)- from its junction with Drakelow Lane for a distance of 8m in a northerly direction and 6m in a southerly direction.

Drakelow Lane (south side)- from its junction with C2019 for a distance of 17m in a westerly direction.

Drakelow Lane (north side)- from its junction with C2019 for a distance of 17m in a westerly direction.
