NOTICE OF CONFIRMATION OF AN ORDER

HIGHWAYS ACT 1980 & WILDLIFE AND COUNTRYSIDE ACT 1981 WORCESTERSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL

DIVERSION OF FOOTPATH BB-594 (FORMERLY FOOTPATH 50), AND FOOTPATH BB-596 (PART) (FORMERLY FOOTPATH 51) IN THE PARISH OF BELBROUGHTON.

PUBLIC PATH DIVERSION AND DEFINITIVE MAP AND STATEMENT MODIFICATION ORDER 2023

On 20 June 2024 Worcestershire County Council confirmed the above order made under Section 119 of the Highways Act 1980, and Section 53A(2) of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981.

The effect of the order as confirmed is to divert the footpath/s and modify the definitive map and statement for Worcestershire accordingly:

FOOTPATH BB-594 From: The length and entire width of footpath BB-594 to be diverted commencing at its junction with Chadwich Lane at Ordnance Survey Grid Reference (OSGR) SO 9556 7700 (point A on the order plan) proceeding south-southeast alongside the hedge for 205 metres (m) to the corner at OSGR SO 9564 7682 (point B). The path continues east-northeast alongside the hedge for 100m to a stile at OSGR SO 9573 7686 (point C). To: The length of footpath BB-594 with a width of 2m, commences at a pedestrian gate in the field boundary on Chadwich Lane at OSGR SO 9571 7706 (point J), the footpath proceeds in a southerly direction for 207m across the field to the pedestrian gate at OSGR SO 9573 7686 (point C).

FOOTPATH BB-596 From: The length and entire width of footpath BB-596, to be diverted commences at its junction with BB-594 and BB-595 at OSGR SO 9573 7685 (point D) proceeds easterly for 32m to OSGR SO 9577 7685 (point E), then east-northeast for 55m to OSGR SO 9582 7688 (point F). The path then turns east-southeast for 44m to OSGR SO 9586 7687 (point G) and from thence south-easterly for 44m to OSGR SO 9589 7683 (point I). To: The length of footpath BB-596 with a width of 2m, commences at the pedestrian gate and junction with footpath BB-595 at OSGR SO 9573 7684 (point K). The path proceeds along the south side of the southern track fence in an easterly direction for 150m to pedestrian gate at OSGR SO 9588 7686 (point L). The footpath then heads south-south-easterly for 21m to OSGR SO 9589 7683 (point I).

As shown on the order map.

The order comes into force as from 20 June 2024 but if any person aggrieved by the order wants to question its validity, or that of any provision contained in it, on the ground that it is not within the powers of the Highways Act 1980 as amended, or on the ground that any requirement of the Act, as amended, or of any regulation made under the Act, has not been complied with in relation to the order, he or she

may, under paragraph 2 of Schedule 2 to the Act as applied by paragraph 5 of Schedule 6 to the Act, within 6 weeks from 15 August 2024 make an application to the High Court.
