Worcestershire County Council in exercise of their powers under Section 1(1), 2 (1) to (3) and 4 (2) and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (which said Act is hereinafter referred to as "the Act of 1984") and of all other powers them enabling in that behalf, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the said Act of 1984, hereby make the following Order:-

- 1. That Worcestershire County Council (Copenhagen Street, Worcester) (Prohibition of Driving) Order 2006 (Revocation) and (Copenhagen Street, Worcester) (Prohibition of Driving) Order 2020 is hereby revoked in its entirety.
- Save as provided in the Schedule to this Order no person shall except upon the direction or with permission of a police officer in uniform cause or permit any vehicle to proceed in that part of Copenhagen Street which lies between its junctions with Deansway and High Street in the City of Worcester in the County of Worcestershire unless they have a qualifying exemption as specified.

In this Order:

"Bullion Vehicle" mean Vehicles constructed or specially adapted for the carriage of cash valuables or other valuable securities to be used to travel to and from Banks or Building Societies and businesses immediately adjacent to specified roads, only for so long as may be necessary to enable such cash valuables or securities to be loaded from and to the Vehicles.

"carriages for the disabled" means a mechanically propelled vehicle the weight of which unladen does not exceed 254 kilogrammes and which is specially designed and constructed, and not merely adapted, for the use of a person suffering from some physical defect or disability and is used solely by such a person.

"Motor Vehicle" means a mechanically propelled vehicle intended or adapted for use on the roads as defined in Section 185 of the Road Traffic Act 1988.

"Pedal Cycle" has the same meaning as in Regulation 4 of the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2016 and means a unicycle, bicycle, tricycle or cycle having four or more wheels not being in any case mechanically propelled unless it has an electrically assisted pedal cycle of such class as to be treated as not being a Motor Vehicle for the purpose of the Act.

"Vehicle" means a Motor Vehicle or any other vehicle unless specifically exempted by the provisions of this Order.

4. The restriction, prohibitions and requirements imposed by this Order are in addition to and not in derogation of any restriction, prohibition or requirement imposed by any other enactment and any exception or exemption to the provisions of any other enactment.

5. The Order shall come into operation on 12 September 2024 and may be cited as the Worcestershire County Council (Copenhagen Street, Worcester) (Prohibition of Driving) Order 2006 (Revocation) and (Copenhagen Street, Worcester) (Prohibition of Driving) Order 2020 (Revocation) and (Proposal) Order 2024

 junctions with Deansway and High Street in the City of Worcester in the County
 of Worcestershire unless they have a qualifying exemption as specified.

In this Order:

"Bullion Vehicle" mean Vehicles constructed or specially adapted for the carriage of cash valuables or other valuable securities to be used to travel to and from Banks or Building Societies and businesses immediately adjacent to specified roads, only for so long as may be necessary to enable such cash valuables or securities to be loaded from and to the Vehicles.

"carriages for the disabled" means a mechanically propelled vehicle the weight of which unladen does not exceed 254 kilogrammes and which is specially designed and constructed, and not merely adapted, for the use of a person suffering from some physical defect or disability and is used solely by such a person.

"Motor Vehicle" means a mechanically propelled vehicle intended or adapted for use on the roads as defined in Section 185 of the Road Traffic Act 1988.

"Pedal Cycle" has the same meaning as in Regulation 4 of the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2016 and means a unicycle, bicycle, tricycle or cycle having four or more wheels not being in any case mechanically propelled unless it has an electrically assisted pedal cycle of such class as to be treated as not being a Motor Vehicle for the purpose of the Act.

"Vehicle" means a Motor Vehicle or any other vehicle unless specifically exempted by the provisions of this Order.

 The restriction, prohibitions and requirements imposed by this Order are in addition to and not in derogation of any restriction, prohibition or requirement imposed by any other enactment and any exception or exemption to the provisions of any other enactment. The Order shall come into operation on 12 September 2024 and may be cited as the Worcestershire County Council (Copenhagen Street, Worcester) (Prohibition of Driving) Order 2006 (Revocation) and (Copenhagen Street, Worcester) (Prohibition of Driving) Order 2020 (Revocation) and (Proposal) Order 2024
