

Map of Celvestune Way, Droitwich and the prohibition of waiting zone implemented by the above order.

Description of the map

The map shows the prohibition of waiting zone on Celvestune Way, **Droitwich:**

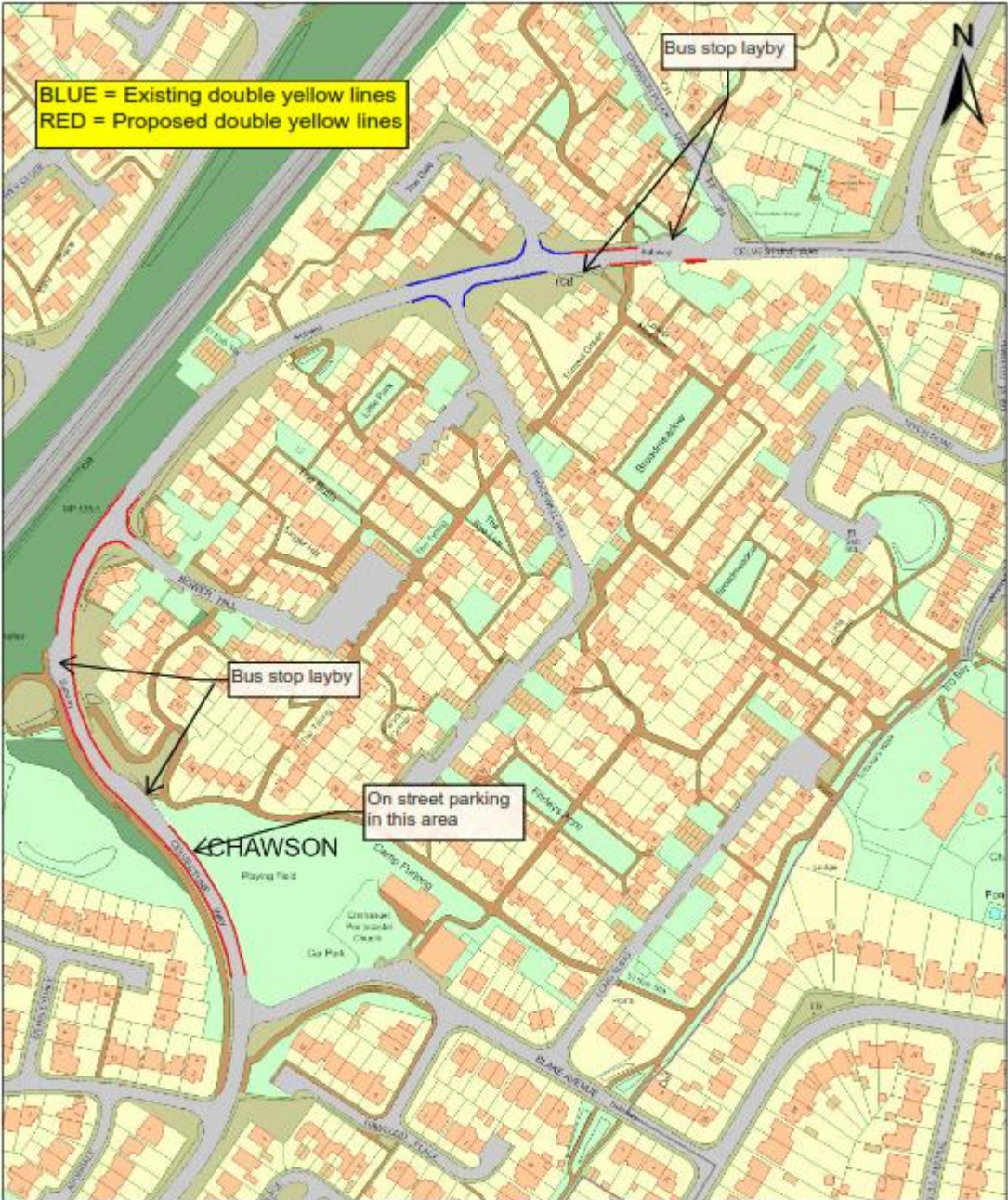
Celvestune Way, Droitwich (North Side): From a point 10 metres east of its junction with The Dale for a distance of 29 metres in an easterly direction.



East side: From a point 5 metres north of its junction with Blake Avenue for a distance of 86 metres in a northerly direction. From its junction with Bower Hill for a distance of 110 metres in a southerly direction and a distance of 10 metres in a northerly direction.

South side: From the garage block access opposite Chawson Pleck for a distance of 19 metres in a westerly direction and a distance of 10 metres in an easterly direction.

West side: From a point 5 metres north of its junction with Blake Avenue for a distance of 166 metres in a northerly direction. From a point 10 metres north of its junction with Bower Hill for a distance of 78 metres in a southerly direction.

Bower Hill, Droitwich (Both sides): From its junction with Celvestune Way for a distance of 10 metres in an easterly direction.
