 i. determine the form and contents of the PPCOs; ii. take all necessary steps to secure the making, confirmation and implementation of PPCOs including the publication and service of all statutory notices on relevant parties, the investigation of and response to objections (including the negotiation and completion of any necessary agreement and undertaking in order to secure the removal of objections to the PPCOs), the preparation and

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 finalisation of a statement of case or written representations, the presentation of the case at any public inquiry or via written representations and all other associated procedural steps; iii. take all appropriate actions for making amendments, modifications and deletions to the PPCOs including updates and corrections as necessary to finalise and secure confirmation of the PPCOs; iv. suspend or abandon the PPCO proceedings or withdraw any PPCO; v. take necessary action to deal with all matters relating to PPCOs (including the payment of statutory compensation) including, where required, instituting or defending proceedings; and, vi. take all other necessary action to give effect to these recommendations; i) Approved the use of the Council's powers under section 203 of the Housing and Planning Act 2016 to appropriate land for planning purposes and override the existing rights and covenants on land required to deliver the Hampton Bridge Scheme that would be infringed by or impede the construction, operation or maintenance of the Hampton Bridge Scheme and delegate their exercise to the Strategic Director for Economy and
Infrastructure in consultation with the Cabinet Member with Responsibility for Highways and Transport;
j) Approved the proposed funding strategy for the Hampton Bridge Scheme as set out in paragraphs 22 and 23;
 k) Recommended to Full Council a transfer of funding (virement) of £4.6 million from the Integrated Block Funding line within the previously approved Capital Programme into the Hampton Bridge scheme; and,
 Authorised the Strategic Director for Economy and Infrastructure, in

	consultation with the Cabinet Member with Responsibility for Highways and Transport, to award construction and any other contracts necessary to complete the Scheme.
