The map shows the proposed experimental prohibition of waiting zones on Eachway and Holmes Drive, **Rednal**:

Holmes Drive: (North side) from a point of its junction with Eachway for a distance of 10 metres in a westerly direction.

(**South side**) from a point of its junction with Eachway for a distance of 10 metres in westerly direction.
