I am writing from the bottom of my heart to ask that the Inspectors do not allow the proposed quarry to go ahead.

I do not believe the assertions from the quarry company that they will make the area better. It is perfect as it is and has been for the 60 years I have walked through 'the parks' to and from school and later as part of my regular exercise for my wellbeing and mental health. I always think to myself when I am by the Castle Gates that 'it is always a good day when you can see the Malverns' and hate the thought that a future generation will miss out. Indeed I also have strong doubts about the length of time they will quarry as I understand that requests for extensions are common so that will be generations missing out.

I am also concerned about the heavy lorries that will have a huge impact on the local road infrastructure and people's day to day lives. The pollution they will add to the air, on-top of the particulates from the quarrying will impact in ways that won't be known for years.

I am unable to be at the Stourport Manor to show my support for the objection but have followed on-line. I would have been there in person if I could.
