TO WHOM IT MAY CONCERN

Re: Natural Resource Services Holding Company Limited

In my capacity as Company Secretary, I can confirm that Natural Resource Services Holding Company Limited (“the Company”) has been accepted as a Member of the Mineral Products Association Restoration Guarantee Fund (“the Fund”).

As such, any of their mineral extraction permissions which include an obligation to restore excavation voids, would be covered by the indemnity provided by the Fund.

In the event that the Company were to fail financially without meeting their restoration obligations, the Fund could pay for any such works to be carried out, up to a maximum of £0.5 million per individual claim and £1 million in total. The circumstances under which a claim could be submitted to the Fund are explained further in the document ‘The MPA Restoration Guarantee Fund ...An industry pledge’ (2015) which is provided with this letter for reference.

The Company must give at least 12-months notice to expire on 31 December in any calendar year if they wish to cease to be a member of MPA Scotland and alongside it, the Fund.

In the unlikely event that the Company were to cease to be a member we would post the fact on our website and use every endeavour to inform all appropriate planning authorities well in advance of the end of the notice period.
