### The order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984

#### WORCESTERSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (PARISHES OF SALWARPE AND MARTIN HUSSINGTREE) (40 MPH SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 2024

Worcestershire County Council in exercise of their powers under Section 84 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (which said Act is hereinafter referred to as 'the Act of 1984') and all other powers them enabling in that behalf and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act of 1984 hereby makes the following Order: -

- 1. No person shall drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 40 miles per hour along those roads specified in the Schedule to this Order
- 2. No speed limit imposed by this Order applies to vehicles falling within regulation 3(4) of the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011 when used in accordance with regulation 3(5) of those regulations.
- 3. This Order may be cited as Worcestershire County Council (Parishes of Salwarpe and Martin Hussingtree) (40 mph Speed Limit) Order 2024 and shall come into operation on XXXXX 2024

#### SCHEDULE

Lengths of roads in the Parishes of Salwarpe and Martin Hussingtree:

**C2139 (Ladywood Road):** From its junction with C2139 (Strand Lane) in a northerly direction to its junction with C2086 (Copcut Lane).

**C2086 (Copcut Lane):** From its junction with U41201 in a westerly direction to a point 330 metres north of its junction with U41200.

**U41200 (Porters Mill Road):** From its junction with C2086 (Copcut Lane) for 650 metres in a south westerly direction.

**U41008 (Station Road):** From its junction with C2139 (Strand Lane) for 540 metres in a southerly direction.

**C2139 (Strand Lane/Church Lane):** From its junction with C2139 (Ladywood Road) in an easterly direction to its junction with A38 Droitwich Road.

**U41208 (Church Lane):** From its junction with C2139 (Strand Lane) for 263 metres in a westerly direction.

**C2086 (Copcut Lane):** From its junction with U41201 in a westerly direction to a point 330 metres north of its junction with U41200.

**U41200 (Porters Mill Road):** From its junction with C2086 (Copcut Lane) for 650 metres in a south westerly direction.

**U41008 (Station Road):** From its junction with C2139 (Strand Lane) for 540 metres in a southerly direction.

**C2139 (Strand Lane/Church Lane):** From its junction with C2139 (Ladywood Road) in an easterly direction to its junction with A38 Droitwich Road.

**U41208 (Church Lane):** From its junction with C2139 (Strand Lane) for 263 metres in a westerly direction
