Date of Decision*	18 December 2024
Summary of Decision*	The delivery of an ERP system including a Finance module. This will improve budgeting and general ledger, automate P2P, allow better supplier management / intervention and improve financial reporting and coding so that the Council can have a real time view of its financial position.
Reason(s) For Decision*	 This was required as the current system is coming to the end of its life. A sourcing exercise using the Crown Commercial Services G Cloud 14 Framework Agreement was undertaken with proposals being received from: One Advanced (current supplier proposing new solution) Technology One Unit 4 The evaluation panel agreed that both Unit 4 and Technology One could deliver a new ERP however the TechnologyOne ERP OneCouncil was the preferred option as it could be delivered within the financial envelope of what the Council currently paying for its current E5 system but with greater additional functionality. This new



	system also has other modules that the Council can choose to switch on a later date without the need for additional procurement requirements.
	The OneCouncil solution is also developed and installed by Technology One directly and not by third parties which the evaluation panel felt would lead to a less complicated environment should issues occur during the build.
Alternative Options Considered and Rejected	See above
Summary of any financial implications	Annual cost for OneCouncil solution is £254,959 pus a one off cost of £11,450. This presents a small saving against current costs for E5 and a larger saving against future costs
	None for Phase 1 however any additional functionality or enhancements outside of the proposal of would be chargeable. A Board is being created to manage key Council systems and the evolution of requirements.
Summary of any legal implications	The Council has followed a process to award this contract which is compliant with the Public Contract Regulations 2015 and the Council's own Contract Standing Orders and Procurement Code by using the Crown Commercial Services G Cloud 14 Framework which is available for use by all local authorities and other public sector bodies. The Call-Off contract has been awarded to Technology One under Lot 2 – Cloud Software.
Consultation process and results	A Proc 2 document (the plan) was taken to Commercial Board discussing the challenge the Council faced and the approach to procuring a new ERP system. This was approved.
	A Proc 4 (the result) was taken to Commercial Board in December 2024 and it was approved that the Council proceed with Technology One.
