# The Mainstream School Accessibility Matrix

This Matrix gives an indication of which tax funded mainstream schools within the County offer pupils with physical disabilities (PD), reasonable access to the curriculum. For the purposes of this matrix, accessibility is defined in three main bands, Blue, Yellow, and White. A further band, Green, is included to show where works are taking place that will likely improve accessibility. Schools are listed within their relevant educational district (pyramids) to include feeder schools where appropriate.

- These are schools that have reasonable access to the curriculum and supporting accommodation, as well as a fully functioning Bathroom Management Area (BMA).
- These are schools where access to the curriculum and supporting accommodation is limited and additional work is needed to be able to better accommodate students with PD. These schools do not have a BMA.
- These are schools at which building work is on site or planned to be carried out within the LA's various building programs and may include specific access works. Once these works are completed these schools will be given either a blue or yellow rating.
- These are schools which have challenging accessibility issues or are yet to be assessed for specific PD accessibility purposes. These are schools where, consequently, the LA will need to consider providing greater resources to enable PD pupils to be able to access the curriculum and supporting accommodation or schools that are not able to be fully adapted.

## **Reviewing Education Provision**

The Council constantly reviews all educational provision, it's program of school building works, and other relevant funding sources. Therefore, the following Matrix is subject to frequent update. The Matrix is maintained by the Operational Manager Accommodation, Corporate Landlord Services, Commercial & Change, Worcestershire County Council.
