DECISION:	 Cabinet: (a) approved for consultation the draft Net Budget Requirement of £495.253 million, as set out in Appendix 1 (b) requested Cabinet Members continue to work with their respective Strategic Directors and Assistant Directors to identify further options to reduce the current reported gap by either additional savings or agree strategies to reduce the current growth and demand assumptions prior to the final budget report which is due to be presented to Cabinet on 6 February 2025 (c) approved for consultation the new savings identified by Strategic Directors as set out in Appendix 2a (d) noted the current MTFP position as set out in Appendix 3 (e) noted the earmarked reserves schedule as set out in Appendix 4 (f) agreed that it was minded to recommend to Council in February 2025 an increase in Council Tax precept of 2.99% and increase in the Adult Social Care Levy of 2.0%

	(g) noted that under his powers as Section 151 Officer, the Chief Financial Officer has written to Government to request Exceptional Financial Support (EFS) in the form of a capitalisation direction to support the budget in 2025/26 and 2026/27 financial years.
