

# **FUTURE SKILLS QUESTIONNAIRE (SEND)**

To support your learners to answer question 6, here are some simple definitions of the pathway options.

## Supported internship

A work-based study programme for 16-24 year olds with an EHCP. Supported interns are enrolled and supported by a school or college but spend most of their learning time in a workplace.

## Supported apprenticeship

A paid job where employees learn and gain workplace experiences and skills. Reasonable adjustments can be made to make the apprenticeship inclusive to all.

### Supported employment

Supported employment is usually provided by a 3<sup>rd</sup> party organisation to give employees with disabilities extra help and support. A job coach is usually provided to support the employee to find and stay in a paid job.

#### **Further Education college**

Colleges offer a range of courses in a range of subjects and levels.

#### **Extended work placement**

An opportunity to try different types of work with an employer.

### Supported enterprise/volunteering

An opportunity to work for yourself, creating your own business. Volunteering is unpaid; however, you can learn new skills and gain workplace experience.
