Scheme C – High Level Landscaping Plan

Alternative Text Description:

This map shows a summary of the proposed vegetation/tree removal and the subsequent planting proposals for Scheme C of the A38 Bromsgrove Route Enhancement Programme. This scheme is in Bromsgrove on the A38, Charford Road and Stoke Road junction.

Proposals are as follows:

On the south side of Charford Road next to the junction, six trees with Tree Preservation Orders will be retained and protected.

An area of vegetation removal is proposed on the north side of Charford Road, for a length of approximately 70m from the junction. This is required to facilitate the carriageway widening and footway improvements. The removed vegetation will be replaced with specimen and native trees nearby.

On the east side of the A38, to the north of the junction, an area of vegetation removal approximately 125m long is proposed between the junction and the existing path onto Warwick Avenue to accommodate the highway works. The removal will be entirely on the A38 side of the vegetation, with suitable vegetation coverage retained between the A38 and Warwick Avenue.

On the north side of Stoke Road, adjacent to the bridge over Spadesbourne Brook, vegetation removal is proposed to accommodate the highway widening and footway improvement works.

On the south side of the Stoke Road left turn slip road onto the A38, one tree is proposed for removal to accommodate the footway improvement works. A further three trees are at risk of removal.

Other existing trees and vegetation in the Scheme C area will be retained.

Some verge areas will be grassed with a wildflower grass seed mix and/or receive bulb/wildflower planting.
