Decision taken under the following delegation:	Under Section 89 of the Countryside and Rights of Way Act (2000) local authorities covering (part of) a National Landscape have a legal duty to prepare or to review a plan which formulates their policy for the management of the National Landscape and for the carrying out of their functions in relation to it. The legislation also states that local authorities should then adopt and publish the plan.
