Worcestershire County Council in exercise of their powers under Section 84 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (which said Act is hereinafter referred to as 'the Act of 1984') and all other powers them enabling in that behalf and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act of 1984 hereby makes the following Order: -

- 1. No person shall drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle along those lengths of roads specified in the Schedule attached to this order at a speed exceeding 20 miles per hour.
- 2. No speed limit imposed by this Order applies to vehicles falling within regulation 3(4) of the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011 when used in accordance with regulation 3(5) of those regulations.
- 3. This Order may be cited as Worcestershire County Council (Various Roads, Bewdley Town Centre) (20 MPH Zone) Order 2025 and shall come into operation on 3 April 2025.
