Introduction

Where an admission authority uses feeder school as part of their admission arrangements, this information must be made available for parents to identify those named feeder schools. Please note that not all schools have named feeder schools. This document provides you with the full details of the feeder school arrangements in place in Worcestershire.

The Council also constantly reviews the educational provision available in the county, for its accessibility and resourced SEN provision in mainstream schools. The council has a program of school building works and monitors other relevant funding sources. The information in the tables in this book in relation to accessibility and resourced SEN provision are subject to updates as building programs complete. This document is a live document.

Feeder Schools

Within each area a pyramid of schools exists. Feeder schools are schools which are named in a schools' admission policy and form pyramid arrangements for the next phase of education. Please note not all schools use the Feeder School connection in their admission arrangements. Please ensure that you check the admission policy for any Academy, Foundation, Free or Voluntary Aided School to ensure you are aware of any feeder school links named in the policies.

Mainstream School Accessibility Information

The Worcestershire County Council Accessibility Strategy and school accessibility plans are a requirement of Schedule 10 of the Equality Act 2010 to increase access to the curriculum and the physical environment of schools. Each school in Worcestershire has varying degrees of accessibility and the following categorises each school.

Categories of Schools

Category A - These are schools that have reasonable access to the curriculum and supporting accommodation, as well as a fully functioning Bathroom Management Area (BMA).

Category B - These are schools where access to the curriculum and supporting accommodation is limited and additional work is needed to be able to better accommodate students with physical disability. These schools do not have a Bathroom Management Area.

Category C - These are schools at which building work is on site or planned to be carried out within the Local Authority's various building programs and may include specific access works. Once these works are completed these schools will be given either a category A or category B rating.

Category D - These are schools which have challenging accessibility issues or are yet to be assessed for specific physical accessibility purposes. These are schools where, consequently, the Local Authority will need to consider providing greater resources to enable physically disabled pupils to be able to access the curriculum and supporting accommodation or schools that are not able to be fully adapted.

SEN Provision

Wherever possible, children and young people should be supported to have their needs met within their local mainstream provision. All educational settings are expected to have an inclusive approach and are required by law to make reasonable adaptations or adjustments to the premises and provision to ensure pupil's needs are met.

Where a child or young person is identified as having Special Educational Needs or Disability (SEND), educational establishments should take action to remove barriers to learning and put effective special educational provision in place. This is called SEN Support. Worcestershire County Council has produced the SEND Graduated Response guidance, which is intended to be used as a tool for schools and settings, to help ensure children and young people across the County with SEND reach their full potential. Resourced SEN Provision types

Some schools offer resourced provision for pupils who have a specific SEND need.

Early Years Language Classes (EYLC) support pre-school age children (aged 3-5 years), who have speech, language and communication difficulties and disorders which require specialist input.

School Age Language Classes (SALC) support children in KS1, KS2 and KS3/4. Places in Language Classes are allocated by Speech and Language Therapists, not by direct application to a school.

Mainstream Autism Bases (MAB) and **Enhanced Mainstream Autism Bases (EMAB)** support pupils who have an Education, Health and Care Plan (EHCP) and a primary need of Autism. Pupils in a MAB/EMAB will spend some of their time in mainstream classes but also receive specialised autism specific provision in the Base. Places are allocated by the SEND Services Team and pupils must have an EHCP in place.

Primary SEN Units support pupils with a specific need such as Speech, Language and Communication (SLCN) or Social, Emotional and Mental Health (SEMH). Pupils will spend at least half of their time in the Unit but will also access some mainstream classes. Places in a SEN Unit are allocated by SEND Services and pupils must have an EHCP in place.

Reviewing Education Provision

The Council constantly reviews all educational provision, its program of school building works, and other relevant funding sources. Therefore, the following tables are subject to frequent updates.
